

International Congress on Community Nursing 2016

5th and 6th May, 2016

Submission Guidelines

A | Authors must submit abstracts to **International Congress on Community Nursing 2016**, until 23:59h, 30th November 2015, by accessing the online submission platform at www.esenf.pt

1. Themes must focus on Community Nursing contexts in a 300-word document (maximum)
2. Works must be original and presented to the public for the first time
3. Authors will receive paper acceptance notification, by e-mail, until 20th December 2015
4. Submission proposal, Portuguese or English, must include:
 - 4.1. Work title, author's reference (underline which author to contact): name, phone number, e-mail and workplace;
 - 4.2. Abstract (letter size 10; line space 1,5; justified text, letter type "Trebuchet MS" and must include: Introduction; methods; results; discussion; conclusion);
5. For each work there is a maximum 5 author's acceptance, and the lecturer must be registered for the Congress, therefore registration must be duly submitted until 30th March 2016.
6. Abstract will be submitted to the Congress Scientific Committee review. There will be no final results appeal
7. Final work must be sent by e-mail until 1st May 2016
 - 7.1. File name must be the full work title

8. A certificate will be issued for each work/lecturer
9. For each registered person a maximum of 2 works is accepted
10. There is a maximum 10 minute presentation for each work

B | E-book

Authors wishing to have their works published in the e-book must submit the article on-line, at the previously mentioned e-mail address, until 5th March 2016, according to the following guidelines:

b.1 Articles must be written in type letter *Trebuchet M*, size 10, line space 1,5 and maximum eight A4 size pages.
